## LASER CUT JIGSAWS AND MUCH MORE

Just before the Christmas break I visited the workshops of Robert Longstaff who will be celebrating 30 years in business this year and was amazed by the extensive range of wooden laser cut puzzles and brain teasers he produces. Situated the Oxfordshire countryside, Robert specialises in manufacturing exceptional quality laser cut wooden jigsaws, a technology we will cover more extensively in a future issue. Initially, I was surprised by the sizes which range from 140pcs-560pcs, but after further investigation, realised that with the variety of shaped pieces and as an option, a double sided jigsaws (same picture both sides) these would be as challenging and take more time to complete than a

traditional 1000pc Jigsaw.

One in particular- a circular jigsaw, cut in circles of interlocking jigsaw pieces gave my 'limited picture box' jigsaw mentality a real fright. It looked great in its frame already completed, but once the pieces were in a pile on my Jigsaw mat, would I ever have the ability to complete the challenge? Me! I think I shall just leave it for a future brain teasing session.

Each of these puzzles are complete with a wooden frame and there is also a framing kit available for 100, 140 & 280 piece jigsaws and jigsaw prices range from £15.00 - £50.00.

Robert also produces a complete range of Compact-puzzles and brainteasers for advanced 'puzzlers'. Great for travel and easy to pack, but I don't think I can get past level one and I believe there are 10 levels, which could apparently take a life time to solve. Prices range from £8.00-£10.00

And for the children, great learning tools and the added bonus of being able to replace one lost piece will keep these precious jigsaws going for many generations to come. The complete range is available from Robert Long staff's workshops, but we have selected a few as part of our stock range. If you would like to see the entire range visit www.longstaff.co.uk but we will be featuring a good selection throughout 2006.

We can also arrange for your GOOD quality photo memories to be custom made into unique jigsaws in a variety of sizes, as unique gifts for friends and family or even yourselves. Prices for this service range from £30.00-£75.00 Interesting Facts: Robert Longstaff is listed in the Guinness book of records as the producers of the world's largest puzzle-187,000 pieces as well as producing the smallest. 
## MEET THE ARTISTS and ILLUSTRATORS

Terry Harrison didn't consider Art as a serious option as a school boy in Norfolk, but with the encouragement of a new art teacher, after moving south in 1965 to Farnborough, he took O-Level and A-Level Art at the age of 16. As with most budding Artists, having to work for a living, he used evenings and weekends to perfect his painting techniques and

develop his own style. Demand for his paintings became such that in 1984 he gave up his 'day job' to paint full time. Inspired by Constable and Turner, Terry's favourite subject is of traditional landscapes using watercolours or acrylic. In 1996 he received the prestigious Fine Art Guild award for 'Best up and coming Artist'.
