Jan Van Haasteren (JuH)

Born on Feb 2nd 1936 in Schiedam, Netherlands, Jan Van Haasteren studied painting at school then advertising at college in Rotterdam. He began his career in advertising in the Toonder Studios in 1961 but quickly gained a reputation for amusing illustrations, working mostly on comic-strips from around 1963 before moving into freelance work in 1966 so he could work with more companies. He actually co-founded a magazine 'Free Balloen' in 1975 while still doing lots of advertising work and illustrations for information leaflets and textbooks. He also started working on puzzles around this time (a few 'Popeye' ones), but without much mainstream attention.

Early in the 1980s Heineken and Sean Décor both asked Jan for large comic works to advertise their products. Jumbo had been aware of Jan's work (as he had sent a few unsuccessful smaller drawings to them over the years) but loved these new larger images and in 1983 released the image Jan had created for Scan Décor (The Olympics') as a puzzle then 'Some Like it Hot' (drawn for Colt International) followed by several more existing images.

In 2003, Jan signed a contract for life' with Jumbo, confirming all of his puzzles would be released through them (although Jan still has full control over the ideas and images themselves).

In 2013 Jumbo launched the 'JvH Studio' where Jan, Rob Derks and Dick Heins now collaborate in producing more images under the JvH brand (with Jan having the final say-so on releases). They share ideas and brainstor mamusing situations and characters to keep new puzzles fresh.

Jan's technique is to produce an A3 sketch in pencil of the main situation and comedy characters, before filling in the details and then inking the lines and colouring in. He loves comedy characters and situations and puts many regular items and characters into the drawings for fans to find (eg Shark Fin, Hother in Law, Max the Dog. etc)

Jan still lives on the north Holland coast and likes tennis in his spare time. He doesn't get a lot of free time however, as each puzzle tales 2-3 months to produce and he aims for 3 per year. Despite being 87, Jan seems to be as productive as ever!
